Competitor Enthusiasm Evident at EastGen 4-H Showcase 2012

SPENCERVILLE, ON – Close to 90 participants gathered at the fairgrounds in Spencerville, Ontario from June 29th to 30th for two days of education, skill enhancement, fun and friendly competition at the **2012 EastGen 4-H Showcase**. This was the second youth event for 2012 in a series of four organized by EastGen across their service area.

"As staff, one of the highlights of our year is to work with the next generation who are so enthusiastic, energetic and passionate about the dairy business," said Brian O'Connor, EastGen general manager. The participants then put their skills to the test on show day under the appraisal of judge John Werry of Oshawa, Ontario.
