

EastGen Challenge East 2015 – Summer Fun and Education for Keen Dairy Youth Competitors

MARKHAM, ONTARIO – Excitement was in the air when the 2015 EastGen Challenge East event attracted 100 keen competitors to the fairgrounds in Markham, Ont., on July 10th and 11th for two days of fun, learning opportunities and friendly competition tailored specifically for dairy youth. This was the third of four similar events organized by EastGen and held across their service area this summer.

A quiz followed the education portion, which contributes to final scores for the overall grand champion award.

The participants then put their skills to the test on show day under the appraisal of judge Nathan Thompson from Belmont, Ontario.
