Rivers Flow From Elevate®

A recent Semex photo shoot with 0200HO11385 Westcoast **River** daughters prompted us to delve into how these silky black cows came to exist in two herds across EastGen's Ontario service area.

For those not familiar with River, he's considered an outcross sire being a Guarantee x Montana x Supershot. With Immunity+[®] (one of our very highest at 115), Calving Ease and A2A2 on his side, he's a +3464 GLPI, +3132 PRO\$ proven sire included on EastGen's latest Profit Plus sales flyer. As a young sire River often fit the bill for herds pursuing their goals via the Optimate[™] mating program administered by EastGen.

James Harbers of Fredwill Farms Inc., Brinston, ON, is currently milking five River daughters. Two are in first lactation and the balance in their second. All three in second lactation became pregnant upon first service for both lactations. Harbers uses Elevate to identify the weaker and low immunity cows in his herd to breed them to beef. When picking bulls he uses the TPI scale and insists that they be Immunity+, have good health traits, and be A2A2. Harbers relied on Elevate testing to identify the non A2 cows in his herd.

"My goals are to continue to improve genetics and to soon be producing 100% A2 milk," said Harbers who runs 550 acres and milks 90 cows in a double eight parlour within a four row sandbedded freestall barn.

EastGen Regional Sales Representative Scott Brown, who recently visited, noted that Harbers is also really happy with his Silverridge V Einstein, Claynook Zasberilla and Stantons **Cockpit** daughters.

Meanwhile, further west in the province at Armstrong Manor Farms, Caledon, ON, River was also a high LPI short-term outcross mating option for this long-time Elevate user herd. This 1100 acres cropped operation includes 380 milk cows housed in freestalls and 3X per day parlour milked.

"We didn't even know we had them until Semex asked to picture here. Then we got looking and thought yes, they are kinda good ones," said Philip Armstrong. But don't interpret his comment as a negative. In this case it means the Rivers at Armstrong Manor were largely unnoticed since they're trouble-free. In other words, a dairyperson's dream. Two made Superior Lactation records and the GP-83-2Y pair pictured are fresh again or due back soon after one breeding. These River daughters quietly did their job, producing high component milk as yearlings after having heifer calves by Westcoast Alcove and 3Star OH Ranger-Red. At Armstrong Manor, heifers genomically tested via Elevate under +3300 LPI are culled as the genetic bar and desire to improve productivity and profit continues to rise.
