



## By the Numbers: How John Schenkels Is Building a Healthier Herd

**John Schenkels** is a firm believer in the science of numbers—and those numbers are paying off.

At **Schenkels Farms** near **Miramichi, NB**, John milks 200 Holsteins in a parlour/freestall system and farms 1000 acres, including a large blueberry operation. In this region of the province where only a handful of dairy farms operate, careful cost control and data-driven decision-making are essential.

An early adopter of the **Immunity+®** program when it was launched by Semex, John committed fully from the start, using 100% Immunity+ sires across the herd. Today, as the benefits become increasingly clear, more than 80% of matings still use Immunity+® sires—now with an added emphasis on high **PRO\$** sires to further strengthen profitability.

Genetic progress is closely monitored through the **Elevate®** program, with all females born on the farm genetically tested. **OptiMate™** is used to design matings, and all heifers are bred with sexed semen. Years of disciplined selection and consistent improvement have delivered results John is proud of.

Here's a snapshot of recent Schenkels herd data:

(Based on 254 animals sampled)

- Herd Average: 104 IMM | 105 Calf IMM
- 113 animals above 105 IMM & 100 Calf IMM
- 206 animals above 100 IMM & 100 Calf IMM
- Herd average is just one point shy of what Semex calls "High IMM" bulls
- Top female: 114 IMM | 117 Calf IMM (sired by 0200H007956 Ranger-Red)

EastGen Dairy Solutions Specialist Mike Wannamaker recently reviewed **DairyComp** data from the Schenkels herd and found strong performance differences tied directly to immunity levels.

The data shows a 3-4% reduction in health issues such as pneumonia, lameness, milk fever, retained placenta, and ketosis. Fertility results were even more striking. Higher IMM females (>106) outperformed lower IMM animals (<102) by 12-16% in conception rate, with an 11% higher pregnancy rate overall.

In second and later lactations, high IMM cows were ready to breed nine days earlier, had 30 fewer days open, and averaged a 12-month calving interval.

"These results make perfect sense," says Wannamaker. "When you start with a healthier animal, the fertility pieces of the puzzle fall into place. Cows stay in peak milk longer, spend less time stale, and can be bred to the bull you actually want to use—one that's focused on getting her pregnant." As Wannamaker concludes, "All of these things just add up to put money into your pocket with no additional cost to you."

John agrees. "The immunity numbers on our herd tell us we're on the right track with our breeding program. We believe in the numbers. It's all about the numbers in our game. The science is good, and we use the science."

Genetics are only part of the equation. "We focus not only on genetics—where immunity plays a big role—but also on feet, feed rations, and how we manage transition cows. When everything comes together, it makes a really good herd of cows," John adds.

The results speak for themselves. Last year, the Schenkels herd ranked first in New Brunswick for LPI at +3209 and second in the province for PRO\$ at 1513—with John firmly focused on pushing that PRO\$ ranking even higher in the years ahead.
