Growth was made then to 40 milking cows. Smaller renovations of the old bank barn allowed the herd to grow to 50 cows by the early 1990's. Further renovations of the facility in 1998 (66 cows) and 2004 allowed growth to 78 milking cows in tiestalls. Construction of the bunker silos was made in 2009 as well as conversion of the haylage silo to high moisture corn in 2010. In 2012 the new milking facility was built to house 126 milking cows and 24 dry cows.
