EastGen 4-H Showcase 2013 – Another Spencerville Success Story

SPENCERVILLE, ONTARIO – The 2013 EastGen 4-H Showcase attracted 58 dairy youth to the fairgrounds in Spencerville, Ont., on June 28th and 29th for two days of fun, learning opportunities and friendly competition. This was the first of four similar events organized by EastGen to be held across their service area.

The education theme this year — "The Cow That Never Gets Noticed", prompted presentations by EastGen's Dr. Tim Henshaw and Chantal Charette. A quiz was then written by competitors, largely based on the theme topic. Later that day, Melanie Curtis led a showmanship/handling demonstration for the benefit of participants wishing to sharpen their skills. Day two was show day with showmanship and conformation classes carefully assessed by Judge John Crowley, Hastings, Ont.

An embryo jackpot was once again an exciting feature for Showcase competitors. One embryo was randomly drawn in each class in order to give all participants a chance to win.
