MARKHAM, ONTARIO – EastGen's 2014 EastGen Challenge East event attracted 105 keen competitors to the fairgrounds in Markham, Ont., on July 10th and 11th for two days of fun, learning opportunities and friendly competition tailored specifically for dairy youth. This was the third of four similar events organized by EastGen and held across their service area this summer.
