

Sexed Semen

With the fertility of sexed semen from EastGen becoming comparable to the performance of conventional semen for many herds, sexed semen is becoming an important part of many herd reproductive strategies. With Semex using the latest sorting technology, herds are no longer taking the conception hit from using sexed semen like there once was a decade ago.
